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### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

This will be my last report as President as I feel it is time to step down and hand over to somebody else for a new style of leadership. I am also 'burnt out' over an extremely important battle which should have never eventuated; a battle caused by an unreasonable and illogical decision of the SACA Board to reduce the number of Clubs in the western suburbs of Adelaide. It was a decision made by people, most of whom have had no experience in Grade Cricket Administration and have no experience at grass roots level. The decision caused an immense amount of work, stress and financial cost to the Club and its volunteers.

#### THE BATTLE FOR INDEPENDENCE

We have come from an *Annus Horribilis* to an *Annus Miraculus*. In my 2015 -16 Report I warned that we had a serious battle on our hands and that we had to keep united within the Club and with the Port Adelaide Cricket Club to maintain our history, culture and independence. I also felt optimistic that we would win.

To win the battle it not only cost the Club many, many hours of time away from cricket, but it also cost the both Clubs dearly in financial terms. Both the time and the money would have been much more productively spent on cricket development and on building assets. This was the greatest crisis in the 160 year history of the Club. The previous worst scenario was a financial one during the Great Depression of the 1890's but local businesses were able to bail out the old Hindmarsh Club.

2016 - 17 was a remarkable year both on and off the field but we had extraordinary success because of extraordinary hard work by extraordinary people throughout a totally committed Club.

An outstanding on field season was produced by our relatively inexperienced but highly talented young cohort. West Torrens became the first Club ever to win the Men's 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Triple Crown of the T20, 50 over and Two Day Premierhips. It was very disappointing to note that not one of the SACA Board Members, who had attempted to force the oldest Club in South Australia out of existence, came to the final day of the West End Two Day Premiership (the most important jewel in the Grade Cricket Crown) to witness West Torrens win the Premiership. Only one member of the Board was in attendance on Day One.

There were great results for 2016 - 17 both on and off the field:

- Won the battle with the SACA (to merge or face relegation) and kept INDEPENDENT STATUS
- Won the Men's 1<sup>st</sup> Grade 2 Day Premiership
- Won the Men's 1<sup>st</sup> Grade 50 over Premiership
- Won the Men's 1<sup>st</sup> Grade T20 Premiership
- Both Women's teams played in the Semi-Finals
- Built a \$57,000 asset (Curator's Equipment and Storage Facility)
- Had our strongest and largest Board of Management ever
- Had more volunteers than any other Club
- Won the WSJCA U13 Red Premiership
- Won 8 Individual Premier Grade Medals and Awards (see list in Senior Trophy winners section).

In any changing situation or defensive action, a large support system needs to be in place. The West Torrens District Cricket Club has that in the form of over 75 volunteers, our local State and Federal Members of Parliament, our wonderful sponsors and a strong band of 123 Life and Non-playing Members. In addition we have a very talented cohort of players, numbering close to 200, some of whom have produced extraordinary performances on the field and others who have simply 'filled in' to ensure our Men's or Women's lower Grade teams sent a full complement of players onto the field.

Noaline and I were invited to the Grade Club Presidents Dinner at the November Test match. From the lectern the SACA President, Andrew Sinclair, introduced various guests to the throng. The manner in which I was introduced was quite ironical. He introduced me as:

*"The President of the West Torrens Cricket Club which unfortunately is going through some hard times at present."*

We were doing quite well both on and off the field at the time but the final end of season results both in a playing capacity and in financial and asset terms was even more telling. So much for the prediction!

To win our battle to stay independent there were many contributing factors:

- The diligence of our working party and that of the Port Adelaide Cricket Club in particular their President Maurie Vast
- The legal advice tendered by our eminent QC Jonathon Wells, our solicitor, the late Ian Edgley and Port Adelaide's solicitor Tony Kerin
- The findings of the Parliamentary Select Committee instigated by our Patron the Hon. Paul Caica M.P., which takes its legal advice from the Crown Solicitor (see separate article)

It would be remiss of me not to mention the SACA CEO Keith Bradshaw. Through this difficult journey Keith continually acted in a just and conciliatory manner and helped us along the merger (or alternative) path but any time an impasse was reached he assisted the two Clubs to find an alternative solution to the dilemma and put our alternatives to the SACA Board. His fair minded approach, co-operation and conciliation were of great benefit to both Clubs reaching the best possible result for themselves and also the best outcome for cricket. He could understand the perils of the original decision and the need for an alternative solution. Keith stands out as an extremely astute and honourable administrator and a very genuine human being.

It is appropriate to quote the words of lawyer Denis Danuto from the film in "The Castle" (via Marty Edmunds)

*"In summing up, it's the Constitution, it's Mabo, it's Justice, it's Law, it's the Vibes and .....no that's it ....it's the Vibes. I rest my case."*

Our battle was along very similar lines to the Kerrigan family's battle with a corporate giant in the 1997 film *The Castle*. The difference was that we had to pay for our QC.

#### ON FIELD

I refer you to Cricket Director Brenton Woolford's Senior Report but would add a little. Not only did the Men's First team make history by becoming the first Club to take out the *Triple Crown*, the three 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Premierhips but what is possibly lost in hindsight they rose from the bottom of the table last season. In addition the D Grade which was very well led by Darren Joseph (DJ) reached the 4<sup>TH</sup> Grade final for the first time in 35 years.

Both Women's teams reached the semi-finals with sides loaded with inexperience which augers well for the future.

The Juniors were again very competitive despite the fact that three U16's were considered good enough to hold down permanent positions in 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade and five playing the final round of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade competition.

The Under 13 Reds also won the Premiership in the W.S.J.C.A.

Much has been said about the fight to stand alone and independent by us and Port Adelaide. However, it should be noted that West Torrens and Port Adelaide met in the semi-finals of both the West End 1<sup>st</sup> Grade competition and the One Day (50 over) Cup. Further West Torrens and Port Adelaide are the ONLY two Clubs to have teams in the Finals of BOTH Women's Grades.

The Club had a number of outstanding performers in the Men's and Women's 1<sup>st</sup> Grades.

**Angela Treloar** – Ang became the first West Torrens player to win the Women's 1st Grade Wicketkeeping Trophy. She also won the Batting Aggregate and Average for the Women's 1st Grade.

**Daniel Drew** – Drewy became our first Bradman Medallist since Paul Nobes in 1987-88 and captained the 1st XI to the West End T20 Cup at Adelaide Oval

**Leigh Drennan** – Lethal is our first Charlie Walker Wicketkeeper since Brad Cachopa in 2009-10. He also won the David Hookes Medal for the best player in the 2 Day Grand Final.

**Kelvin Smith** – Kelvin captained the 1st XI to the West Cup (50 over) and West End 2 Day Premiership.

**Spencer Johnson** – won the Rob Zadow Medal for the best player in the West End Cup (50 over) Grand Final.

**Lauren Ebsary** reached another milestone when she scored 102 (82b.) against Kensington. This took her to 11 1<sup>st</sup> Grade centuries for West Torrens overtaking Ben Higgins and Andy Smith on 10. Only Ron Hamence, Alan Shepherd and Paul Nobes are ahead of 'Beeper' each with 12 'tons' to their names.

#### WESTERN SUBURBS JUNIOR CRICKET ASSOCIATION

West Torrens has been fielding 3 x U13 teams and 1 x U11 team in the W.S.J.C.A. an Association that we helped to set up. We also assist Community Clubs in the Association by having many of their players participate in our Young Eagles Development Squad program and insisting that those young boys and girls play with their Community Club until they are ready for SACA teams.

However, Cricket Australia 'in its wisdom' has deemed that any elite Clubs who participate in Junior Community Associations must withdraw those teams. Unfortunately some SACA officials support this move although the WSJCA voted to allow us to remain. In addition the Club was threatened with a reduction in our SACA grant if we didn't comply (in defiance of the PSC Recommendation #4 and #8 – see separate articles for Recommendations). West Torrens is grateful for the diplomatic intervention of CEO Keith Bradshaw to allow West Torrens a three year transition period to phase out these teams.

This dilemma flies in the face of the letter which we received from Andrew Sinclair (President SACA) dated 7 December 2015 regarding a directed merger involving West Torrens which stated that "there exist too many Clubs on the western seaboard given the population projections and demographics.....". To make West Torrens reduce the number of its junior teams is a stark example of an oxymoron.

It is quite incredible that some administrator sitting in an ivory tower in Jolimont, Victoria, can decide what is best for the children of families residing in West Beach, Henley Beach and Lockleys without any research.

#### CLUBROOMS

Those who visited home games during the season undoubtedly experienced the inconvenience of the Club having the use of the Clubrooms for only 7/26 weeks of the season. This was an unfortunate experience as the Henley Football Club had received a substantial grant to renovate the Clubrooms. However, for reasons unknown to the WTDCC work did not start until 9 months after the proposed date. The builders then struck substantial problems. Consequently we lost out on Saturday night Presentations. However, we are indebted to one of our major sponsors the *Grange Hotel* and also to the Woodville Rugby Club for allowing us to proceed by holding these on their premises. Naturally there was a big loss of revenue to the Club.

During the long building process Latisha (Polkinghorne), Wimp (Alan Hutton) and Hutto (Peter Hutton) and other helpers had to endure Gulag conditions for 19 weeks of the season. The rest of us owe them a huge vote of thanks for the work in keeping people 'victualled' out of the West End caravan. A very big thanks also to West End for supplying the caravan and Tony Jones who secured it. Because of the renovations we lost the chance to host the Australian U19 Championship matches and the Senior Country Carnival and to hold social functions. As a result we lost a further large amount of revenue.

#### VOLUNTEERS

For the first time in many seasons we were able to fill all Board vacancies at the AGM. The Board is a very active and forward looking body with every member being able to bring some different attribute(s) to the table so that we 'cover many bases'. Unfortunately Amy Agnew is not in a position to continue as Secretary due to ill-health and family commitments. I would like to thank you Amy, for taking on the position when we were in need and for the wonderful job which you did. Our sub-committees again functioned wonderfully well despite the lack of Clubrooms.

I wish to make comment on the great work which Chairman Scott Jones did in his first season in the role. He was 'thrown in at the deep end' when we were faced with extinction or at the least relegation. I relied on him heavily for advice and support and went ahead confidently knowing he was there as a back-up. Scott did a

magnificent Power Point presentation to the SACA Board on 29th February 2016 which the Board all but ignored and was a strong voice on our working party to fight the merger/relegation issue. Thanks a million Scotty.

Kent Sendy did a remarkable job as the Sponsorship Co-ordinator and we had 39 wonderful people or businesses contributing to the welfare of the West Torrens District Cricket Club. In addition Julie Brown assisted in the drive for player sponsors and 41 were achieved in this category.

Gary Rennie carried out his duties in his first year as Treasurer very efficiently particularly as we had a larger amount of capital income and expenditure to deal with than in other years, finishing more than \$20,000-00 in the black and building a large asset. The large asset in the new Curator's Facility and Storage Room which is valued at about \$57,000-00. - talent I.D. followed by
- recruitment and development of the recruits
- annual income to exceed expenditure (business management)
- sufficient volunteers and/or remunerated workers
- obtaining and maintaining suitable facilities.

We are doing all of these well but we mustn't go backwards. West Torrens still needs a lot of help in workers and in capital.

### PARLIAMENTARY SELECT COMMITTEE

After the decision of the SACA to compel the West Torrens and Port Adelaide Cricket Clubs to merge or on face relegation to Second Grade, our Patron and local Member, the Hon. Paul Caica successfully moved a motion in the SA House of Assembly to establish a Parliamentary Select Committee to enquire into SACA's decision.

The Select Committee comprised:

The reasons given by the SACA for their decision to force a merger or relegate a team from 1<sup>st</sup> Grade were:

- The poor standard of the 1<sup>st</sup> Grade competition was responsible for the Redbacks being cellar dwellers in the national competitions
- To eliminate the bye, (which contrary to the Board's view many players accept and enjoy)
- There were too many Clubs in the western suburbs for the population to support

We argued the case that none of these reasons were correct and eventually succeeded in that approach although the road was extremely arduous and time consuming. The evidence provided to the Clubs was flimsy at best while we discovered that there was further undisclosed information taken into account by the SACA.

The evidence given by some SACA officials to the PSC showed a distinct lack of transparency, hidden agendas, a lack of knowledge of Grade Cricket administration, and refusal to acknowledge the efficiency and future planning of the West Torrens District Cricket Club. In addition there was an obvious avoidance of what we have achieved in our history and more importantly in recent times.

After our first appearance we had to return to the PSC to refute the incorrect and misleading evidence given by some SACA officials which misrepresented the West Torrens position. It is obvious from the PSC Report that this impartial Committee accepted our evidence rather than that offered to the contrary. All of our Members and Players can thus be very proud of the Club's evidence to the Parliamentary Select Committee.

The Select Committee recommended that:

1. The merger should not proceed because:
  - a. SACA did not have the power to proceed with a merger without first receiving a recommendation from the Grade Cricket Committee
  - b. Of a lack of evidence to support such a decision
  - c. Reducing the number of Clubs in the western suburbs is likely to compound issues of low participation
2. The SACA review its Junior Development program and work with western suburbs Clubs to address lack of participation
3. That Board should be seen to be transparent and fair in how it arrived at its decision.
4. SACA demonstrate to Clubs that it plans to address issues of trust (and how it will address these issues) as was highlighted in the Zadow Report and that this be commenced prior to the end of the 2016 - 2017 season

5. The SACA introduce a process that allows Board Members to declare and distance themselves from decisions about Clubs with whom they have an affiliation
6. It should be made clear that Section 43 of the Constitution does not allow the BoM to negate the role of the Committees of Management in the manner suggested by the SACA
7. It should be made clear that Objects in Section 3.1(a) of the Constitution are relevant to each level of the cricket pathway
8. SACA should not use financial levers to force Clubs to agree to terms and conditions that the Clubs do not wish to accept
9. SACA creates a mechanism for a cost-effective and independent arbitration of disputes between the SACA and/or its BoM
10. Procedures for filling casual vacancies created by the resignation or retirement of Board Members be reviewed and modified to prevent Board appointees dominating the makeup of the Board.

The PSC has done a great service in identifying issues that can be used by a new SACA Board to help them in developing a much improved and healthier culture in South Australian Grade Cricket particularly as the PSC identified the unprofessional behaviour of the current SACA Board in certain areas.

Unfortunately the SACA BoM has already acted in a manner to ignore the following recommendations:

#4 - nothing has been put in place to address issues of trust

#6 - in relation to the introduction of a 14<sup>th</sup> team or Club

#8 – in relation to forcing West Torrens, Glenelg and Sturt to dismantle junior teams in Community Associations.

The PSC was a huge help in enabling our Club to remain independent. We are extremely indebted to our Patron and Member for Colton, Hon. Paul Caica M.P., for initiating its establishment.

### TREASURER'S REPORT

I have the pleasure in advising that the West Torrens District Cricket Club (Inc) has reported a reviewed **net profit** of \$52,603 for the year ended 30 April 2017 compared to a profit of \$2,751 in the previous year. The result is after bringing to account grant monies of \$37,536 received from the State and Federal Governments for the curators / storage shed. These grant monies were achieved thanks to the great work by Charlie Rumbelow. We had an outstanding season culminating with winning all three Grand Finals which has resulted in prize money amounting to \$12,800.

The **operating profit** for the year is \$15,067 and given the circumstances in which the Club operated over the year, this is a great result and credit must go to all those involved with the West Torrens District Cricket Club. Particularly pleasing is the excellent work from Kent Sendy and his sponsorship team in generating sponsorship income to \$39,784 (2015 - 2016 \$10,182). Due to the clubroom renovations many thanks to Tony Jones for arranging the SA Brewing Van as our temporary canteen and also to the great work from Latisha Polkinghorne and Alan Hutton and their support team in operating under difficult circumstances. During the year an EFTPOS machine was introduced which assisted in takings growth for the canteen and fundraising events.

Some of the other key factors which affected our result for 2016 - 2017 were:

- Grant monies of \$26,500 received for coaching, Young Eagles Girls Academy and practice equipment.
- Fundraising & Canteen income up on previous year thanks to the great work of our fundraising team
- the junior fundraising team and
- the success of our on field achievements.
- Clothing discrepancy (Income \$11,595 Cost \$19,940) was offset by sponsorship monies and player subscriptions.

#### FINANCIAL POSITION

As at 30 April 2017 the net assets of the Club were \$109,254 (2015 - 2016 \$56,651).

During the year the curator/storage shed was completed and added \$43,586 value to our facilities. The Club's contribution was \$6,050.

Cash at Bank was \$22,166.

#### LOOKING AHEAD

At 30 April 2017 the Club is in a healthy financial position however, we must continue to build upon that in coming years. The 2017 - 2018 year will present a number of new challenges but with the support of our members, sponsors, and volunteers will allow us to maintain a strong financial position to achieve on field success.

In finishing my report I thank the Board for their support and assistance in my first year as treasurer.

I also take the opportunity to thank Denis Brien (Rocka) for his support and I have very much enjoyed working with him throughout the year.

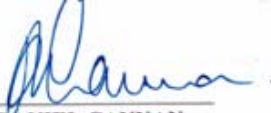

### SENIOR MEN'S CRICKET REVIEW

Season 2016 - 2017 was a record-shattering year for the club with 1<sup>st</sup> grade premierships in the 20/20, 1day competition and 2-day competition. This was the culmination of many years of work for this group of players who were supported in their development by numerous people at our club. The previous season had brought many challenges for our club, which included threats of extinction as a single entity from SACA.

#### YOUNG EAGLES ACADEMY - BOYS

This squad continued successfully for its eleventh season and comprised 18 boys from middle to upper Primary school level and representing Grange, Fulham and Plympton Footballers/Cricket Clubs besides our own. The program was conducted by former Test all-rounder Eric Freeman, former state cricketer and Australian baseballer David Mundy and myself. I would like to sincerely thank the Australian Cricketers Association, through their local representative Wayne Phillips, for contributing to the coaching honorariums of Eric and David, and the generous support of Bendigo Bank (West Beach) towards junior player participation.

Players were selected through trials at the end of the 2015 - 2016 season and a little over half came from Community Clubs and the rest from our own Under 13's and Under 11's.

The aims of the program are:

- To provide extra coaching for players who will probably play SACA cricket for West Torrens and to assist in the development of players for future RSS, Under 14 and Women's teams.
- To help the players learn more about the game from experienced current and former players
- To provide recreation and fun for 10, 11 and 12 year olds.
- To further increase the profile of the WTDC in the area by assisting young players from Community Clubs.

As in previous seasons Eric, David and I concentrated on the basic skills of correct technique for shot making and bowling action while David honed the fielding skills. All senior T20 references (TV shots) were vetoed – that is no improvised type of shot now endemic in senior T20 games! Get the basics right first!

The squad had 10 training sessions and an excellent match against a similar squad from Kensington at Ford Oval Kensington Gardens under the watchful eye of former Kensington and Woodville player Sam Turner.

It is pleasing to note that three former Young Eagles now have been awarded SACA player contracts; Brooke Harris (Scorpions) and Spencer Johnson and Daniel Drew (Redbacks). All three have played in 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Women's or Men's Premierships and this season Daniel won the Bradman Medal for the best player in Men's 1<sup>st</sup> Grade and Spencer the Rob Zadow Medal (Best player in the 50 Over Grand Final). Brooke and Daniel were also selected in the Women's and Men's Teams of the Year.

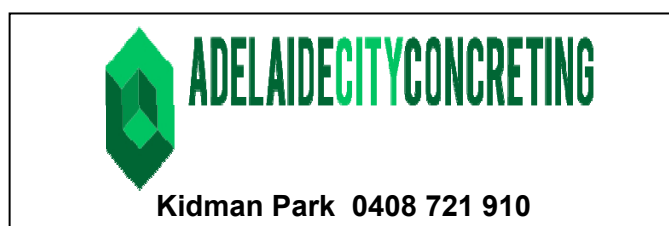

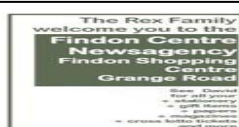
