The role of President of a Premier Grade Cricket Club can be a challenging yet very satisfying role. On-field we had another premiership from our amazing Women's 1st Grade team in the 1-Day competition, we had great success in the Junior T20 comps with each Grade making at least the Semi and our U16 Reds & Men's 2nd Grade teams made it to the finals of the two day competition's before the season was ended prematurely due to the onset and restrictions associated with Covid-19. We are excited about the large group of extremely talented cricketers who are graduating from our U16 teams into senior ranks this year and expect that they will provide some wonderful additions to our senior teams.

Prized recruit Ryan Gibson (from NSW) has already begun coaching some of our juniors in the Winter Academy alongside Mark, Brenton (and Brad on occasion).

The pursuit of new changerooms continues with the latest suggestion being that we should have the new facility up and running by the start of the Women's season in early November (or shortly after). We are looking forward to that and once again thank all the negotiating and hard work done by the HFC and its leaders Rod Hill & Paul Caica with builders and respective government authorities during the process. It will be superb to have one of the two changerooms dedicated to the Blue & Gold of the WT Eagles and one to the Navy Blue & White of the HFC Sharks.

We are continuing to communicate with SACA (& CA) for the final piece of the funding puzzle to enable us start our new training facility. The State Government & Local Council have already offered their funding so once we have the word from SACA we will move on that. As part of the funding we are raising awareness of the ability of our supporters to donate through the Australian Sport Foundation (<https://asf.org.au/projects/west-torrens-district-cricket-club/>) which enables all donations to be tax deductible. We have raised over \$7000 and have also had several other past players donate directly to the club which shows what this great club still means to so many people. If you haven't visited the website, there is further information on the project, and we'd love for anyone to help out by pledging a donation!! The current players are so appreciative, and we look forward to building on one of the better training facilities in SA cricket soon.

I'd like to take the opportunity to wholeheartedly thank Greg Stanford who is stepping down from the board. Greg is a dedicated West Torrens man and while he will no longer spend some of his Monday nights at board meetings, he will continue to provide great support in any way he can for many years to come. I'd also like to personally thank our current SACA delegate, Tony Jones, who is vacating his position but has offered to help out when & where he can around the club going forward which is very much appreciated. We also had a change of Treasurer mid-season with Gary Rennie handing over to current player and accountant Ben Williams. Gary did a wonderful job and has been close at hand helping Ben through his first few months in the role. Thanks Gary!

Undoubtedly some players have, or will, move on and I'd like to wish them all the best in their pursuits both off and on the field and they can be assured that they will always be welcomed back to the Eagles nest.

Looking forward we will continue to work with all our players to improve their skills and push for team success as well as striving to get players to the next level. We take great pride in developing our youngsters from the Young Eagles Academy all the way up to 1st Grade & beyond. To have so many players contracted to either SA or Australia is a testament to that. Congratulations to Daniel Drew who joins (new dad!) Callum Ferguson as a contracted Redback player for 2020-21. Kane Richardson has secured a contract with Cricket Australia as has Tahlia McGrath. While Sheagles Ellie Falconer and Amanda-Jade Wellington have full Scorpions contracts.

Once again thank you to everyone who has helped make season 2019-20 a success and I look forward to season 20-21. I feel confident that with the people we have at our disposal we will

continue to improve and be a great asset to SA cricket.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Firstly, I would like to give a massive thank you to Gary Rennie whose tenure as Treasurer came to an end in January. As a club we appreciate everything you have done over the past few seasons.

The financial statements for the club for the year ended 30 April 2020 are set out on the following pages and show a net profit of \$11,314 compared to \$17,351 last year. On adding back the depreciation expense of \$9,040 the club recorded an operating profit of \$20,354. Given that the 2019 profit includes a donation of \$25,000, the 2020 profit is a positive result for the club.

Some of the significant income and expense results for 2020 are as follows:

- SACA Distributions and Prize Money were a total of \$56,100, up \$4,254 from 2019. This is largely due to the \$9,100 prize money received thanks to the Women's 1st Grade winning the premiership.
- Sponsorship income for the year was a healthy \$29,645. Thanks to Kent and everyone involved that helped achieve this result for the club.
- Canteen and Catering generated a profit of \$8,673 (\$30,112 income, \$21,439 expenses), compared to \$8,261 in 2019. This is another fantastic result and would not be possible without the hard work of Latisha Polkinghorne, ably supported by Alan Hutton, Peter Hutton, Richard Williams and Michelle Capel. Another big thank you to Jess Joseph and Jordan Capel for organising multiple fundraising functions, all the junior parents who have assisted with presentation nights, and countless others who have volunteered their time throughout the year.
- ACA Funding remained at \$15,000.
- Total expenses saw a decrease of \$27,406 compared to the previous year, due to large drops in maintenances expenses, sponsorship expenses and canteen expenses.

Financial Position

As at 30 April 2020 the club's net assets sat at \$164,989 compared to \$153,675 the year before, representing an increasingly strong financial position for the club. Our total cash at bank as at 30 April 2020 was \$35,710. With the uncertain future of the current climate, our financial position should see us be well prepared to get through what will be a tough time for all. To maintain and build on this, it is crucial that we all make the effort to support the club over the next season, whether that be by purchasing food and drink from the canteen, attending fundraising events, attaining new player sponsors, and paying player subs. Achieving this will also contribute to the clubs ultimate goal of on field performance and success.

Thank you to all board members, volunteers, players and sponsors who put in the effort to make the club so great.

CRICKET DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Our results for season 19/20 left the club finishing 7th on the Club Championship. Our first grade disappointingly finished 10th however we did win two games from our last three games in the two day competition after Christmas, which was an improvement. Our women's program was outstanding again with a 1st Grade premiership which will be reported on separately. It was pleasing to see our 2nd Grade make the four who are still a young group of emerging cricketers. Our recruiting for the season focused around bringing in Tim Oakley who had previously played at Tea Tree Gully and been the leading wicket taker in the competition. We were also very fortunate to have Josh Dascombe join our club who was an outstanding addition both as an all rounder and clubman, he unfortunately had to leave after Christmas to take up a new job opportunity in the United States. He finished the season as the leading wicket-taker in first grade with 22 wickets and made 352 runs at 39. Daniel Drew had an outstanding season again making 593 runs at 59 and taking 16 wickets, we also had Bailey Capel have an excellent season with 575 runs at 52. We struggled in both the one day games and 20/20 winning one and two games respectively.

As a club we had experienced a decline in an overall performances in the juniors however this is starting to turn upwards again which is very pleasing. Our Under 16 Reds were very competitive finishing third in the overall competition and we were very competitive in the 20/20 junior competitions playing in the final of the 16 Red and 14 White 20/20 competitions. The club Academy and the Young Eagles program are providing an outstanding basis for the development of our players, we currently have 15 junior cricketers participating in the Club Academy during the winter time. For season 2020/21 we have been fortunate to recruit Ryan Gibson from New South Wales which will add quality to our 1st Grade line up. As a club the future is exciting and we look forward to this season with great anticipation. . These are trying times for our community and the West Torrens spirit that is such an outstanding part of our club culture will hold us in very good stead. Our club is in a very strong financial position and we believe that with the continued development and improvement of our Men's and our Women's program we can be the dominant club in Grade cricket in South Australia.

The T20 component of the season was slightly disappointing in terms of team results, but was brilliant to see some young players exposed as leaders in the team when our state players were away. Paris Hall was our leading T20 run scorer with 134 @ 33.50, whilst Emily Hinze began to show her striking talent with the bat. Emily Parsons also showed her metronomical economy as a seam bowler, despite not taking a large bag of wickets.

Tessa Davis, Issy Bryksy, Tegan Fry, Lucy Myer and Emily Parsons all continued to add to their tally of 1st Grade games throughout the season, whilst showing numerous signs and contributions that they belong at 1st Grade level.

The fortunate situation that we do have in our 1st XI is the depth of state representation amongst our ranks, with Tahlia McGrath, Amanda-Jade Wellington and Ellie Falconer all representing the Scorpions and WBBL Strikers. Upon the return of our state representatives, we were easily one of the stand out teams in the competition, with a mixture of seniors, experience and young up and coming talent. Thank you to Denis Brien and the committee for their continued support throughout the season.

I would like to thank the players and West Torrens community for welcoming me to this great club in my first year. It has been a privilege and a joy to coach this group of cricketers, and I would to congratulate them on a well-deserved premiership. Despite losing their opportunity to compete in the finals, I have no doubt that they would have prevailed to become premiers in the One Day format if they had the opportunity to play. There are going to be some special things coming from this group in season 2020/21.

The 14 Whites were an extremely young team with many of the players eligible for another 2 years at this age group. After a slow start to the season, we developed quickly as cricketers and as confidence and belief grew, produced a very consistent season, only just missing the finals in the last round. Expect an exciting future from this group!

Ray Sutton Shield is played in the five weeks of the season and our team comprised many of these same young U14 White players, many getting their first taste of weekend Premier Cricket. While we found the opposition challenging, the benefits from this experience will stand us in good stead when most of these players return for the same competition in 20/21.

Thanks to some of our young Sunday Women's cricketers who are also important members of our junior teams.

The Young Eagles Academy continues to develop early cricket skills and good fundamental techniques in young cricketers. Watching the development these boys and girls displayed through the course of a season is incredible. Unfortunately, the U12 Statewide Cup competition was cancelled due to the weather but nevertheless, games against other Clubs were still arranged and importantly the squad was able to apply their learning together on the field as a team.

Awareness Rounds

Each year there are several rounds that promote awareness of different issues in our society, including:

- **FeBLUary Round** – Shines the spotlight on anxiety, depression and other issues relating to mental health and is particularly relevant in these times of COVID-19. Keep an eye out for your mates and if you are feeling down, please talk to someone.
- **Reconciliation Round** – Introduced in 2019/20 to recognise Aboriginal culture with an aim to strengthen the relationship between Aboriginal / Torrens Island and non-indigenous people.
- **Pink Stumps Day** – In recent years WTDCC has led this initiative in SA Premier Cricket by raising awareness and funds for the McGrath Foundation Breast Care Nurses who help patients with breast cancer. It has become a landmark day on our cricket calendar for each Grade.

Thanks to players and families for supporting these initiatives with genuine respect and acknowledgment, which is a measure of the values and quality of our people at WTDCC.

Thanks to the Country players and their families who travelled every week, and to those who came and played a few cameos with their City teammates. We look forward to our young City and Country players enjoying many years of cricket together.

During the first half of the season, teams of U14 and U16 West Torrens City players travelled to play West Torrens Country Zone Teams at Artherton. We always enjoy the welcoming country hospitality and great facilities organised by the hosting country families. It's a fantastic experience for our City

players to travel and participate in these country matches, and the competitive opposition provided for the Yorke Peninsula teams are an important part of their preparation for the Country Week Carnivals.

Young Junior Development

This year also saw a shift in the early development of young juniors, with WTDCC no longer fielding teams in the local WSJCA Community Competition which also created an opportunity to engage more strongly with our local Community Clubs.

This year's Academy welcomed a brand new squad of girls eager to learn and become the best cricketers they can be. Throughout the season the girls developed skills in batting, bowling and fielding whilst developing game sense and strategy in modified games and practice matches.

The girls willingness to learn was evident through their questioning, commitment to training and their ability to reflect on their own development, which resulted in major improvements to their confidence and skill level across all aspects of the games.

- * To help the players learn more about the game from experienced current and former players
- * To provide recreation and fun for 10 to 13 year olds.
- * To further increase the profile of the WTDCC in the area by assisting young players from Community clubs

As in previous seasons Eric, David and I concentrated on the basic skills of correct technique for shot making and bowling action while David honed the fielding skills although each of us participated in all the various segments of the coaching. Jarrad took control of the centre wicket sessions at John Mitchell Reserve. This was a new innovation to have the lads gain extra experience on turf pitches and simulate match conditions. Former Test spinner Dan Cullen made a number of guest appearances and his assistance was very much appreciated and received enthusiastically by the players. A big thank you to all of these Coaches.

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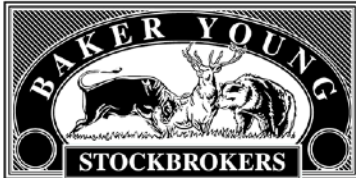


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
