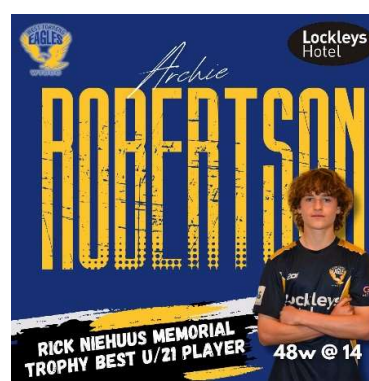
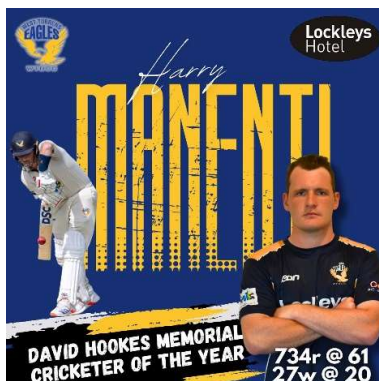

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

With SA winning the Shield & One Day competition double, it's been a great year to be involved with SA cricket. We can hold our heads high with the knowledge that finally the Men's squad have joined the Women's program and become a well-respected outfit. It was great to take in some of the SA games during the year and seeing Bucks bowl a great spell on day one of the shield final was very pleasing. Congratulations to all the WT boys who played a role during the season with Harry & Daniel playing in the One Day Grand Final and Spencer & Jake playing their part in what was an incredibly successful campaign.

Unfortunately, at WT, we didn't add any silverware to the trophy cabinet, but we did once again make finals in all three Men's 1st Grade comps, stumbling in the Semi's of both the two day & T20 comps. We had two of our three Saturday junior teams make finals and we have high expectations of them continuing to perform well next year. While the Women's second grade came up short in their One-Day Grand Final.

Given the lack of on field ultimate success, the offseason has already been a very busy time. We welcome a new coach into our Sheagles program to partner with Head Coach "Froggy" Murdoch. Chris Secker joins us from an extremely successful stint in Western Australian Women's Cricket and will take charge of the 1st Grade on match days. We hope he adds to the 4 premierships his yeams have won in the WACA 1st Grade. Season 25/26 also will see former WT & SA 2nd XI player Wes Thomas join our coaching panel; he'll join Youngy & Remy and work predominately with our batters on Thursday's. Kelvin Smith will join our coaching ranks as 1st Grade Senior Men's Coach, assisting Hags during the week and taking the reins on game days as a player/coach.

Our board will undertake some minor changes as we lead into next season, Logan Pastyn will step down as Cricket Director but will still be available to help the club wherever and whenever possible. Cathy Barratt isn't seeking to be reappointed as Board of Management Chair and Mark Whenan will pass the baton of Junior Coordinator onto Matt Lokan. We thank all these people for all the great work they have done in those roles. Mark will, hopefully, continue as a board member & of course 4th Grade Captain! David Rex has put his hand up to replace Logan, which hopefully will be ratified at the upcoming AGM along with all the other reappointments.

Long time servant, Denis Brien has been replaced by Brianna Cheetham as chair of the Women's Cricket Committee and Andrew Capel will take over the Chair of the Men's while past players David Rex & Trent Kelly have been added to it.

Off field, the upgrade of the John Mitchell Oval playing square has been completed, and while a couple of games were played in the last few weeks of the season, perhaps a little ahead of time, the full benefits will start to be seen from season 25/26. Recently, we have been the beneficiary of a further \$20k additional grant from SACA to help fund facilities. Thanks to the quick work of Trent Kelly, we have already been able to attend to an upgrade/renovation of our turf training pitches which should result in much better outcomes for all players. Hags has been instrumental in overseeing the transformation of one of our storage sheds into a small training area & gym which will see players being able to train and/or do rehab in any weather which is a great addition for all our coaches & players.

Finally, thank you to all those who contributed both on & off field during the past season, some wonderful new additions to the club in both the junior & senior ranks who will continue to strive to push the club forwards. As always at this time of year there will be players, volunteers & families that move on, some to other clubs and some to "retirement". Without singling anyone out, a big thank you for your efforts and the success that you have helped WT attain during your tenures at the club, all will be missed and hard to replace.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The club's financial statements for the year ended 30 April 2025 are set out on the following pages and show a net loss of \$34,186 compared to a profit of \$19,860 last year.

This may seem like a disappointing result, however it is largely a timing difference due to the expenditure associated with the John Mitchell Oval upgrade for which the club received funds in 2024. These funds were sitting in the club's bank account as at 30 April 2024 but weren't spent until this season. Although the majority of the costs were covered by various funding and grants, the club still used a portion of its own funds to complete the project.

Canteen income saw a decline in 2025. A significant factor contributing to this is the scheduling of the fixtures, and the fact that the grades rarely lined up, which affected our ability to plan and implement social functions and presentations nights. This seemed to be an issue for many clubs in the competition, so we hope the upcoming season has a fixture which aligns the grades, and we can see an increase in this area, as it is a crucial part of the club's finances.

The cash at bank as at 30 April 2025 sits at \$25,043, which is a healthy figure, and more in line with previous years. To continue to develop and improve the club's facilities, as was done at John Mitchell, we need the continued support of our players, members and sponsors. Ultimately this will lead to an environment where players at all levels can benefit and grow and help to bring success to the club for many years to come.

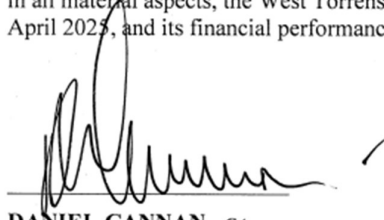
Assurance Practitioner's Responsibilities

MEN'S CRICKET REPORT

The preseason involved recruiting several 1st grade players to continue to compete with other clubs as they were heavily recruiting to avoid relegation to Division 2. We were lucky enough to recruit Jake Fraser-McGurk although with his Australian white ball commitments, Big Bash and South Australian selections we knew we wouldn't see much of him. We also recruited Seamus Keogh who played 1st Grade in Port Adelaide's 2-day Premiership the previous season. I was aware that he had been batting lower than his ability so was looking forward to what he would bring with not only the ball but his batting and had an outstanding season leading our wicket taking and making his first 1st Grade century. Finally we recruited Jack Carson, an Irishman who plays County Cricket for Sussex, continuing our close relationship with the club that Sean Hunt plays for also.

Jack was an important part of the team make-up as we needed a 1st grade spinner to replace the retired Dan Fallins. Seb Young returned from a season off to Captain the 2's, Matt Ferraro continued as the 3rds Captain and the season saw a return of 4th grade at the Club with Mark Whenan leading a very young side. The First Grade managed to have success playing finals in all 3 formats. Unfortunately, no silverware was gained as we were hit quite heavily with player unavailability and injury come finals time. It also didn't help in the 2-day comp that we played one less game due to Glenelg refusing to play at our ground because they didn't find the run ups satisfactory. This decision in hindsight may have cost us a top 2 finish giving us a home ground advantage in the semi-finals. 23 players played 1st grade this season which was the most during my past 9 seasons as coach. Of course, this does have a flow on effect and the 2nd grade who looked like playing finals all season but missed out in the end as they were quite depleted from the team that played most of the season. Consequently, a tough season for the 3rds and 4ths but lots of opportunity and experience gained for the younger players at our club. The club had Jake Fraser McGurk and Spencer Johnson both play for SA, Big Bash teams and Australia in white ball formats. Daniel Drew and Harry Nielsen played for SA, both winning a One Day title as well as Big Bash teams. Jordon Buckingham played for SA, winning the Shield Final as well as Big Bash and Aussie A. Harry Manenti played Big Bash and SA 2nd XI while Seamus Keogh and James Ruether both played for the SA 2nd XI. Lots to look forward to next season!!

YOUNG EAGLES CRICKET ACADEMY REPORT

With the change in age groupings for our Junior Playing Squads for season 24/25 it meant a slight change in how we structured our WT Young Eagles Academy. Many of the players who would have been attending the academy were included in the new U13 WT playing squad as U12 players. This meant a drop in numbers down to 45 for the academy however due to the size of the U13 squad many of the players that missed games spent time honing their skills on a Monday Night which resulted in our usual numbers of 50-60 at most sessions.

The academy was very lucky to have Paul Duffett join as a regular coach and he and his "assistants" Liam & Archie, from our U15.5 team took a rotating group of 15-18 players for match play simulation/centre wicket sessions every week at either HHS or John Mitchell Oval. Down at Henley Oval, Jack Carson (UK County Player), Archie Robertson & Hannah Knowles joined head Coach Mark Harrity as regular weekly coaches. Englishman Sean Hunt & newly capped striker and 24/25 Bradman Medallist, Harry Manenti also spent time helping the players develop their skills through the summer. Once again it was fantastic to have Stephen Cavanagh take the warmups for the players every Monday and David Rex was on call to give a hand on many occasions.

The cap presentation for our new players was once again one of the highlights with Spencer Johnson, joining his SA team mates Daniel Drew & Jordan Buckingham, to give out caps & shirts to the players. They then spent time taking photos and talking to all the academy players which is always a great thrill for everyone in attendance.

We already have over 20 new players ready to join next year's Academy and almost as many signed on to return, so once again we will look to cap the numbers at around 45-50 players. In addition to last year's coaches, we have added Chris Secker (who is also coaching our W1 team on game day) to our ranks and he will ensure that our academy program continues to offer its members a great place to learn & develop their cricket skills.

The Academy, supplemented with a few of our U12s from our playing squad, played one off games against Kensington, Prospect and Woodville, winning all 3 games with 31 players getting an opportunity to play at least one game. The highlight was against Prospect where we made 183 from 30 overs and bowled them out for 138. The day/night game that was played between the younger members of the 24/25 academy against some of those who will join the squad for the upcoming season, was outstanding, a game that was played in great spirits under lights at Henley Oval with lots of talented young cricketers on display.

Feats of historical importance in season 2024-25

During the WBBL Spring Challenge round at Karen Rolton Oval, the *Sheagles* players created a new state record when **SIX** West Torrens players took the field for the Strikers against the Perth Scorchers on 11 October (Round 1). No Club has ever previously had six women in a S.A. senior State team in the same match. The players were **Jemma Barsby (capt.)** Yr.12 student **Maggie Clarke, Paris Hall, Katie Mack, Maddie Penna** and **Amanda-Jade Wellington**. This was repeated in Round 3.

Jemma Barsby played her 100th WNCL match when the Scorpions played Victoria at Karen Rolton Oval on 31 January. She has also played 125 WBBL games. An extraordinary feat from a quality person. Congratulations JB!

Angus Petherick recorded the 2nd best match figures for a West Torrens Under 16 (now U.15.5) when he took 10/35 (match figures 4/7 & 6/28) against Port Adelaide in the U.15.5s. The best figures of 10/33 (5/23 and 5/10) were set by another Y.P. lad **Ben Davies** v. Northern Districts at Gleneagles Res. in February 2017.

Chloe Rosenzweig (60) and **Mckenzie Holy (14 n.o.)** created a new record for the 10th wicket in 50-over games when they put on 38 against Glenelg surpassing the 36 (unf) stand of **Caroline Ward** (43 n.o.) and **Charley Phillips** (18 n.o.) v. Kensington at Henley Oval, January 2022. This was Chloe's first match for West Torrens.

In the first One Day Cup round **Daniel Drew (143 n.o.)** and **Harry Nielsen (86 n.o.)** created a new 4th wicket partnership record for West Torrens in the 1st Grade One Day comp when they put on an unfinished 170 v. Sturt at Park 25 (#2) overtaking the previous best of **114 by Daniel Drew (72)** and **Daniel Fallins (48 n.o.)** also v. Sturt but at Price Memorial Oval, in January 2022. The team score in this match (3/336) was the third highest ever by a West Torrens team in a 50 over OD game. The best being **4/408** v. Adelaide at Henley Oval, November 2021.

A record Opening Stand of 183 was created for the 2nd Grade was created by **Charlie Edmunds 111 (112 b.)** and **Hudson Walshaw (51)** v. Tea Tree Gully at Pertaringa Oval on January 18. The previous best partnership of 171 has stood for 36 years and was by former coach **Grant Wyman (210)** and **Andrew Horsnell (94)** v. University at Adelaide Oval #2 in February 1988.

Ella Simpson (41) and **Brianna Cheetham (29)** created a new Women's 2nd Grade 7th wicket partnership record when they added 53 v. Sturt at Price Memorial Oval, Hawthorn in Round 11. The previous best was 34 by **Brianna (116)** and **Emillya Pope (5)** v. University at Henley, Oval, February 2024.

Kelvin Smith has moved into the top three run scorers of all time for West Torrens 1st Grade while **Daniel Drew** has moved into 9th spot. The runs exclude runs scored in the stand-alone One Day competition. The all-time leaders are:

Cricketing Family Brother **Arthur 'Affie'** (Australia, South Australia, Hindmarsh and West Torrens) Brother **Henry** (Hindmarsh) Nephew **Harwood Jarvis** (South Australia and West Torrens)

Arguably the best all-rounder produced by the Hindmarsh - West Torrens clubs was Alfred (Fred) the younger brother of international wicket keeper 'Affie' Jarvis. He received his nickname from scorers who found that they had two A. Jarvises on their sheets and so shortened Alfred to Fred, hence the name F.Jarvis on the Club Honour Board. He made his 1st Grade debut for Hindmarsh at the age of 16y. 309d. having begun with the Hindmarsh Second XI when fifteen. He and other young colts from the 'Bricks' also occasionally turned out for Hindmarsh Friendly Society, a group which played arranged 'friendlies' against local Community Clubs, when they could muster a team. At age 16 Fred scored 103 against Rose Park for the Friendly Society, a feat which brought him under close scrutiny by the 'Bricks' senior selectors. He began with 1st XI in the 1884-85 season and continued in A grade with West Torrens until 1907-08 performing some quite exceptional feats.

A wiry, lean man Fred was used mainly as a batsman and occasional bowler in his first few seasons in the 1st XI. In his 'pomp' however, he was not only a good batsman who had a penchant for powerful off drives and cutting forward of the wicket but added to his armoury was the talent to bowl at a lively pace with indefatigable stamina. He was one of the first two players to achieve the First class 1000 runs and 100 wickets double for South Australia, a remarkable feat seeing he had team mate, the formidable George Giffen, as a competitor. As a bowler he took five wickets in an innings 26 times for Hindmarsh and 15 times for West Torrens, taking a total of 446 wickets @ 22.97 in his club career. His best performance was 8/45 for Hindmarsh against Adelaide at Adelaide Oval (North) in 1891-92 and three times he took eight wickets in an innings for the *Bricks*.

Fred scored three centuries for Hindmarsh and five for West Torrens while making a total of 5213 runs @ 30.48 for the Club. His 169 n.o. against Adelaide at Adelaide Oval (South) was his highest score for the *Bricks*, a game in which he had also claimed 5/118, while a score of 128 versus West Adelaide at Adelaide No.2 was his best effort for the *Eagles*. Fred is one of only four players since the beginning of SACA Club cricket in 1873 to aggregate 100 runs and 10 wickets in a First Grade match, the others being George Giffen (Norwood), Neil Hawke (Port Adelaide) and John Hopkins (Southern Districts). He made 88 and 46 n.o. and took 5/26 and 5/80 against West Adelaide at Adelaide Oval South in 1898-99. Chosen as an opening bowler and all rounder in the West Torrens Team of the Century, he is regarded as one of the Club's greatest players.

In the match against Adelaide at Adelaide Oval in March 1892 both Fred (106) and his brother 'Affie' (126) scored centuries in the same innings, the only time that brothers have achieved this feat for the Hindmarsh-West Torrens Club. The score reached 6/382 on the second day before Adelaide (not the present Adelaide C.C.) decided to forfeit.

Fred's first appearance for a South Australia team was as a 16 y.o. in a non-First class ('against the odds') match for a local XVIII against Alfred Shaw's English X1 at Kensington Oval, a match in which he did not bowl and scored 9 batting at #3. The game was promoted as a development game and the team given the classification as a Junior XVIII. It comprised mostly students from St. Peters and Prince Alfred Colleges plus Fred and strengthened by some senior Hindmarsh players led by Fred's mentor Frank King. Ironically his next appearance at the higher level was FOR Alfred Shaw's next touring side versus XV of South Australia three years later. Again he did not bowl and batted at #11 being undefeated on 7 and sharing a last wicket partnership of 54 with Johnny Briggs. Fred had been a last minute replacement for England all-rounder Billy Barnes who severely injured a leg when he fell out of a train at Ballarat while changing carriages.

In his 54 First class matches he scored 1,767 runs with a top score of 154 against N.S.W. in Sydney where he featured in a partnership of 193 with Clem Hill. He took 107 wickets with

best figures of 6/114 v. W.A. in Perth and 5/33 v. N.S.W. in Sydney and held 37 catches. However early in his cricket career Fred was not as successful as his observable talent foretold, as he was prone to be quite excitable and a little immature. A story was related that during a duck hunting expedition, he became so excited when he saw the game that he fired at will, omitting to take aim or raise the gun to his shoulder.

A quality allrounder, Fred was undoubtedly close to Australian Test selection as he twice played for the Rest of Australia against the Australian XI. The first was in Adelaide prior to Joe Darling's 1899 tour to England. Batting at #9 he scored 75 n.o. top scoring along with Victor Trumper and was in an entertaining 10th wicket partnership of 77 with Tommy McKibbin. His bowling was steady with 1/31 from his 15 overs. Brother Affie kept wickets for the Rest in this game.

Batting and Bowling trophies were awarded during South Australia's initial First class match against New South Wales at the SCG in February 1890. S.P. (Sammy) Jones won the Batting as he top scored for NSW with 68 and Fred's 4/65 secured the Bowling Trophy. The trophy is still in the possession of Fred's great nephew Peter Baxter.

He was a last minute replacement for Reggie Duff in another Rest of Australia v. an Australian XI at SCG in February 1900. However he was given little opportunity to succeed by his captain and fellow South Australian Jack ('Dinny') Reedman. He was thrown to the wolves and opened the batting in place of Duff and was given a mere 3 overs in each innings, capturing 2/14 in the second.

[Various media outlets headlined these Australia v. The Rest matches as 'International' and others as 'Test matches'. Technically these and intercolonial matches were 'international' as Australia was non-existent as a nation, but merely a group of self-governing British colonies each responsible to Whitehall. 'Test matches' – not by today's definition - were associated with the origin of the meaning of the word – a gruelling match over a number of days 'testing' each team's endurance and talent.]

During South Australia's visit to Western Australia in 1899 Fred took a hat-trick against a Fremantle Combined XI and twelve wickets for the match. He captained South Australia in the First class game against Western Australia which followed the Fremantle contest. He and 'Affie' are therefore the only brothers to captain South Australia in First class matches. Fred wrapped up his First class career in a match against Western Australia at the Fremantle Oval in February 1906, a ground that hosted only five First class matches, all prior to World War 1. The Observer newspaper reported that Fred retired from Club cricket at the end of the 1907-08 season to 'go north' - apparently to Pekina. However he was back in Adelaide by at least 1911 when it was reported that he was playing for the Government Produce Department in a minor Association.

Fred's personal life was often tinged with disappointment and pathos. Business was a pitfall for the Jarvis family including Fred. Their father Robert had also been declared bankrupt as a wheelwright in Hindmarsh. 'Affie' and Fred put all of their money into a sports store which traded under the name of Jarvis Bros. Cricketing Depot at 34 Adelaide Arcade but by August 1896 they had gone into receivership. They unsuccessfully tried to trade out of it and lost everything. However family oral history suggests that they spent more time in the nearby Rundle Hotel rather than on the business premises.

Fred was on the periphery of an unfortunate occurrence in November 1897. His partner May Hurrell, who was a barmaid at and a resident of the Tattersall's Hotel in the city, took ill. She had left the premises on the Sunday and returned the following day. She went to bed but her condition slowly worsened and she was taken to a private hospital where she died. Fred was unaware that anything was amiss with May or that she contemplated the use of drugs. Circumstantial evidence pointed to the possibility of an abortion gone wrong.

However the verdict of the Coroner's jury was

"that the deceased came to her death at Adelaide on November 17 from blood poisoning consequent of a miscarriage but there was no evidence to show how the miscarriage was produced." (SA Register 26 November 1897 p.7)

His great nephew Peter Baxter recalls Fred as being a tall, auburn headed man, somewhat of a loner, and a heavy drinker and smoker. He never married. The unfortunate death of his young girl friend, being snubbed of the rightful wearing of the 'baggy green' and failure in business may well have led to an itinerant life of loneliness. He worked in various parts of South Australia including running the Government Store at Lock 4 Bookpurnong, near Loxton from where he retired. In his twilight years he resided at Peterhead with his sister Beatrice Bastard, Peter and his brother Bob Baxter's grandmother, and where the Baxters also lived. In any back yard cricket games with the Baxter boys Fred tended to avoid the ball. (Beatrice's son had changed the family name from the original French name *Bastard* to avoid obvious disparaging remarks). Bob Baxter recalls that the family had very little interest in cricket after Fred had died and that his father burned all of the Jarvis memorabilia soon after Fred died.

It was a sad end to the life of an extraordinary athlete, one of West Torrens' greatest players, a great cricketer but possibly a depressed and lonely person.

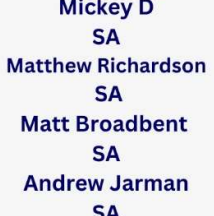

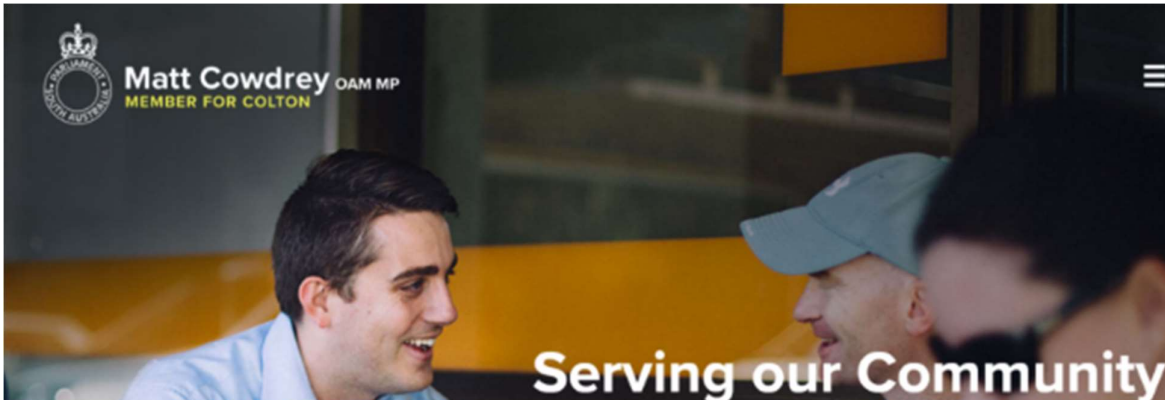
